- 21 credits of Major Electives
- 9 CORE credits
- 81 General Elective Credits
- **Students may transfer a maximum of 75 credits and a minimum of 45 credits must be La Roche College Credits**
- A minimum number of 120 credits are required for degree. The last 30 must be La Roche College Credits. (Developmental course work does not count toward the minimum number of required credits for graduation.)
