Nina Taylor '06 is the Chief Executive Officer for the Center for Election Science in Covina, California.

As CEO she sets the vision and strategic direction for the organization and connects with legislators, lobbyists, academia and advocates to implement voting reform and civic innovation at the ballot box. Her other focuses include guiding the organization's research efforts and policy recommendations related to

electoral systems and reforms, testifying in Senate and State Houses, and providing opportunities for elected officials to expand their knowledge of voter behavior and expression. She also educates the public on the impacts of vote splitting, voting methods and election integrity and security.

Ms. Taylor is the founder of the digital health startup Merald.io and the former Vice President of Learning and Education for the American Society for Radiation Oncology.
