An alumna of La Roche University's Master of Science in Human Resources Management Program, Teresa Sackett, M.S. '93 is now president of T. Sackett Consulting, LLC. Her work responsibilities include providing leadership and career coaching for those going through a transition midway through their lives or careers. She also provides HR consulting services for start-up and established companies focusing on the areas of HR strategy, business/HR initiatives, acquisitions and transitions.

Previously Ms. Sackett was a Senior HR Business Partner at Bayer (2014-2021), where she partnered with global business executives to establish and execute HR strategy and business initiatives. In addition she managed and delivered HR projects for information technology, engineering and business consulting, supporting 1,200-plus employees and managing HR BPs.

From 1993 to 2014, Ms. Sackett held various positions with Fiserv, including Manager of Organizational Development and Senior Vice President of Human Resources. She oversaw 40 locations, three countries and 8,000 associates, led as many as six direct reports and 50 HR professionals, and performed mergers and acquisitions all over the world for the financial services industry. Prior to her career with Fiserv, she held positions in the areas of Cost Accounting, and was Manager of Administration Services for engineering and analytical labs.

Ms. Sackett's volunteer work includes service to Allegheny Health Network, Pennsylvania Women Work, the International Coach Foundation, La Roche University's Alumni Association Board, St. Aidan Parish and Medical Reserve Corps.

She earned a Master of Science in human resources management from La Roche in 1993, and a Bachelor of Arts in business management from Mercyhurst University in 1985
