**In this peace, we know that**

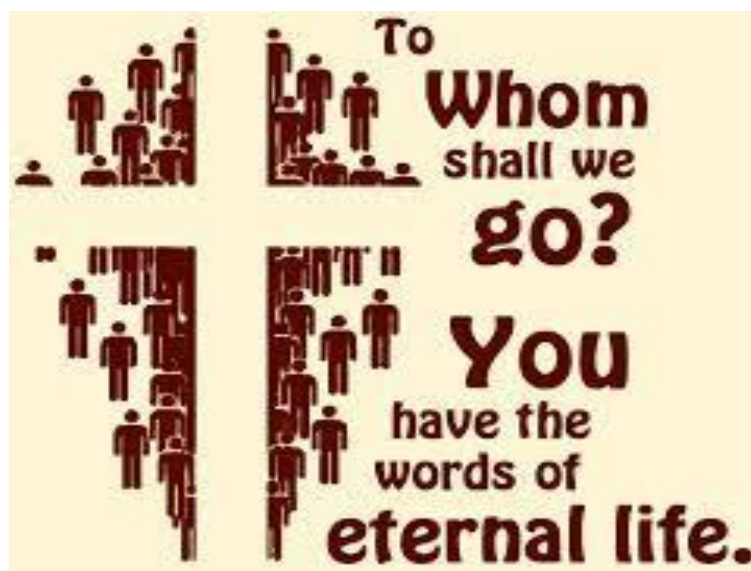
**the love of God surrounds us,**
