Beginning with your first semester of enrollment, your Degree Audit Report in My.LaRoche will automatically track your progress toward your degree, and guide you in planning future class schedules. Review your updated Degree Audit Report with your advisor prior to registering each semester.

PURPOSE: To complete pre-requisites for Phase II of LECOM's Osteopathic Medicine program.

REQUIREMENTS: To successfully enter this program, the following conditions must be met:

- SAT/ACT scores are strongly recommended but not required to apply
- High school GPA ≥ 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, unweighted
- US Citizen or lawful permanent resident.
- Must apply to LECOM prior to start of 3rd year for 4+4 track.

This is an Early Acceptance Program and is provisional. Phase I consists of pursuing an LRU major. To successfully enter Phase II, the following pre-requisites (in conjunction with the requirements of another LRU major) are required:

- 46 credits (34 Science in Biology, Chemistry, and Physics and 12 Humanities in English and Behavioral Science).
- No grade lower than a C allowed in the courses listed.
- No CLEP or P/F credits allowed.
- AP scores of 4 or 5 may be accepted for English and Behavioral Science courses.
- Minimum course load of 14 credits must be taken per semester and semester GPA ≥ 3.0 to remain in program (GPA is progressive: i.e., must get higher the closer to matriculation).
- Minimum overall GPA ≥ 3.4 and minimum science GPA ≥ 3.3 .
- Students enrolled in the EAP may be exempt from taking the MCAT.
- Shadowing a DO (Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine) is highly recommended.

In addition, students must attend a minimum of 2 consecutive years at LRU. All students completing Phase I must be approved by the Preprofessional faculty committee to enter Phase II. There are only 5 seats available each year. LECOM has 2 campuses for Phase II: Erie (including Seton Hill, Greensburg) and Bradenton. Students apply to either but not both.
